Our Purpose

The purpose of this coaching relationship is to help you succeed in your life and ministry involvement as you are guided by the Holy Spirit.

Our purpose for the Crossroads coaching ministry is to foster leadership development, and to help both small groups and individuals gain traction in their efforts to achieve spiritual maturity.

Definition

Coaching is not counseling, nor consulting. Coaching is a process whereby you are empowered to achieve your God-given potential in life. Through good questions, reflective listening, and gentle accountability, the Coach helps you to *discover* God's leading in your life, and to *develop* effective action plans.

Mutual Commitments

Therefore, let's agree to the following guidelines in order to maximize our time together:

1. RESPECT

We will be on time for coaching sessions and if something comes up we will call ahead as soon as possible to reschedule.

2. PREPARATION

We will complete all assigned work prior to the scheduled session so that we get the maximum benefit from the coaching sessions.

3. CONFIDENTIALITY

I make a commitment to you that anything shared in our coaching sessions is held in confidence.

4. INTEGRITY

The purpose of this coaching relationship is to enhance ministry effectiveness and all interaction between coach and person being coached will hold to the highest levels of biblical standards of purity.

5. COACHING TOOL

We will use the CoachNet Coaching Tool for all coaching sessions.
